Also House Bill No. 282, entitled "An Act to authorize and empower the State Roads Commission of Maryland to build, construct and maintain a State road from a point beginning at Reese's Corner, one mile north of Forest Hill, Harford county, and running thence in a northerly direction along said road as now laid out, through Ferneliff and Rocks to Highland, Harford county, and to further define its powers in reference to such building, construction and maintenance." Also House Bill No. 849, entitled "An Act to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Section 58 or Article 6 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Caroline County,' sub-title 'County Commissioners.'" [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Cooper, Legg and Collier.*]

Also House Bill No. 850, entitled "An Act to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Caroline county to borrow money on the credit of said county for the purpose of paying off the floating indebtedness of said county, and to issue bonds for the payment thereof, and to levy taxes on the assessable property of said county to redeem said bonds and to pay the interest thereon." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Cooper, Legg and Collier.*]

Also House Bill No. 790, entitled "An Act to repeal Sections 663-J and 663-L of the New Charter of the City of Baltimore (1915), sub-title 'Installation of Electrical Apparatus and Wiring,' said sections being respectively a codification of the Acts of 1906, Chapter 244, Sections 10 and 12, and to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 663-a, 663-d, 663-e, 663-f, 663-g, 663-h, 663-k, 663-m, 663-n, 663-o and 663-p,
