Endorsed "passed by yeas and nays."

Also, a report from the Secretary of the Harford county Academy, endorsed "referred to the consideration of the House of Delegates."

A bill entitled, an act to pay Henry M. Murray for services rendered the State in the case of McPherson Lyles;

Which was read the second time.
