

An act to appropriate a sum of money to pay Richard B. Carmichael, Grafton L. Dulaney and D. C. H. Emory, for their services as arbitrators under the act of December session eighteen hundred and forty six, chapter 347, entitled, "a supplement to an act for the relief of Passmore McCullough."

Whereas, by the said act, it was provided that the said arbitrators should be paid for their services, as in the said act is provided; and whereas, they have not yet been paid, and to that end legislation is necessary; therefore,

Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, that the Treasurer upon the warrant of the Comptroller is hereby authorized and directed to pay out of any unappropriated money in the Treasury to Richard B. Carmichael, Grafton L. Dulaney and D. E. H. Emory each the sum of three hundred dollars.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
