The rules were suspended to receive a report from the select committee on a bill, entitled an act in relation to the establishment of a light House on Love Point, on Kent Island, in Queen Anne's county, and to cede to the United States the jurisdiction of the State of Maryland in, to, and over a site for the same,

Which was read the first time.
