Leave was granted to the Committee on Lotteries, to report a bill entitled, an act more effectually to prevent gambling.

Mr. Fiery offered the following order:

Ordered, That the Committee on Insolvency, be instructed to inquire into the expediency of exempting from execution property to the amount of three hundred dollars.
