

they may obtain, can probably be raised from that source without detriment to the rights, interests, or convenience of the citizens of the State, and said Committee are hereby authorized, should they deem it expedient to do so, to correspond with the competent authorities of the State of Virginia, with a view to produce concert of action between the two States on this subject, and that said Committee have leave to report by bill or otherwise;

A bill entitled, an act to refund to the President and Directors of the Washington county bank an over-payment of certain State taxes on its capital stock, erroneously made in the year 1853;
