On motion of Mr. Partridge,

The rules were suspended to enable him to report favorably on a bill entitled, an act to authorise the Commissioner of the Land Office to issue a warrant of resurvey and patent for certain lands in Allegany county;

Also on a bill entitled, an act for the relief of George Deneen, of Allegany county, directing the Commissioner of the Land Office to correct the fifth line of a tract of land called "Love in a Village;"

Which was read the first time.

Also asked that the Committee on Judiciary be excused from the further consideration of the bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act for founding a college at Chestertown, and that the said bill be referred to the Committee on Education.

Mr. Silver, from the Committee on Corporations, reported favorably on a bill entitled, an act supplementary to the act to incorporate the South Baltimore Company, passed at December session 1832, chapter 96, and the act amendatory of the act to incorporate the South Baltimore Company, passed January session 1854, chapter 122;

Which was read the first time.

On motion of Mr. Kildow,

The reading of the bills for the second reading be dispensed with, and take up bills for the third reading.
