A bill entitled, an act to refund to John B. Nichols, collector of the 1st collection district of Anne Arundel county, certain moneys overpaid by him into the Treasury of Maryland.

And a bill entitled, an act appropriating a sum of money for the use of James G. Henning, Clerk of the Circuit Court of Montgomery county;
