Resolved, By the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Governor be and he is hereby requested to issue a commission in the usual form to the Hon. Anthony Kennedy, as Senator, to represent this State in the Congress of the United States for six years from the 4th of March 1857;

Which was read the first time, and

On motion of Mr. Hall,

Three fourths of the members concurring, the said resolution was read the second time, and adopted.
