A bill entitled, an act to appropriate a sum of money to pay George W. Dowell late sheriff Calvert county, for certain fees due him by the State.

A bill entitled, an act to authorize Charles S. Middleton Clerk of the Circuit Court for Prince George's county to complete the alphabetical index of land records, and the personal records in his office from the 1st day of January, 1839, to the 1st day of December 1855, which were left incomplete by his predecessors.

A bill entitled, on act supplementary to the act of 1854, chapter 4, passed for the regulation of the catching of oysters in the waters of Somerset county, and entitled, an act to fix the time when the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Somerset county, shall pay over to the Treasurer of the school fund of said county, certain moneys as provide for in said act, and making his official bond liable for the payment thereof.

A bill entitled, an act relating to fines, forfeitures and penalties.

A bill entitled, an act prescribing when, where, and before whom the Governor of the State shall take the oath of office.

A bill entitled, an act to anthorise the County Commissioners of Charles county, to sell and dispose of certain Warehouse property in said county.

A bill entitled, an act to authorise the County Commissioners of Charles county to levy a sum of money for the repairs of the courthouse of said county.

A bill entitled, an act to authorise Jacob Hoff, Edward Keene, and Lewis Turner, trustees, to execute a deed of certain lands in Baltimore county.
