A bill entitled, an act appropriating a sum of money to compensate Henry May, of Baltimore, for legal services rendered to the State, &c.;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Claims.

A bill entitled, an act to authorise Henry West and Christian Dagenhart, Trustees, to convey certain property to certain persons, as Trustees of the United Brethren in Christ;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.
