A bill entitled, an act to amend the act entitled, an act to provide for the election of road supervisors in the several counties in this State, passed at December session 1853, chapter 300;

Was read the second time.

In section 1st, line 2, strike out "in this State" and insert "Charles county;"

In section 2, lines 2 and 3, strike out "in each" and insert "Charles county;"

In section 3d, in 1st and 2d lines, strike out "the several counties" and insert "Charles county;"

In section 5th, line 2nd, strike out the word "any" and insert "Charles county;"
