And the said Abram Requa Agent of the American Publishing Association, and Thomas J. Wilson, have entered into bond to the State of Maryland, in the penalty of one thousand dollars, conditioned for the proper and faithful performance of their contract.

The Committee further report, that they have contracted with Nicholas Brewer of John, for preparing an index to the Acts and Resolutions, and supervising the proof-sheets of the same, for the sum of one hundred and twenty-five dollars, and for indexing the public documents of the present session for the sum of fifty dollars.
