Which was adopted.

Mr. Hall moved to amend by adding at the end of the 1st section, the words "fifteen thousand dollars for the use of the Insane Hospital;"

Mr. Bowling moved to substitute the words "ten thousand" in place of "fifteen thousand,"

Which substitute was adopted.
