Endorsed "passed by yeas and nays, with proposed amendments."

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED:

Strike out the preamble.

Insert in the 7th line of section 1st, after the word "empowered," the words "in their discretion; provided nevertheless, the said county commissioners in their discretion, are hereby authorised to renew the aforesaid loan obtained from the Savings Bank of Baltimore, in which event no funds shall be issued as provided for this act."
