

ACTS OF ASSEMBLY—

A bill reported, making an appropriation to defray the expenses of the surveys necessary under the acts passed January session 1852, ch. 60 and 275, authorising the running and marking the State boundary lines therein mentioned, 497; bill passed and sent to the Senate, 636, 637; returned passed by the Senate; 723.

A bill reported, entitled, an act further supplemental to the act of December session 1827, chapter 111, entitled, an act to regulate sales by public auction, 519; bill passed and sent to the Senate, 703; bill returned passed by the Senate, 833.

A bill reported, entitled, an act to repeal the second section of the act of 1809, chapter 22, relating to the mode of electing Senators to represent this State in the Senate of the United States, accompanied with a report, 522, 523, 524; proceedings on bill, 627, 628.

A bill reported, entitled, an act supplementary to an act passed at January session 1854, chapter 325, entitled, an act relating to the trial of facts in the several Circuit Courts of this State, 537; bill passed and sent to the Senate, 797; returned passed by the Senate, 849.

A bill from the Senate, entitled, an act amendatory of an act passed January session 1854, ch. 172, entitled, an act to regulate fisheries in the waters of the Potomac river, within the jurisdiction of Maryland, and to protect the breed of fish therein, 547; bill passed and returned to the Senate, 711.
