Petition of Samuel Pry and 42 other citizens of, praying that the commissioners of said county be authorized to levy a sum of money to build a bridge over Little Antietam, on the road leading from Kitt's bridge and intersecting with the Boonsboro' and Sharpsburg Turnpike, one quarter of a mile southwest of Hugesville, referred, 331.

Petition of 175 citizens of, remonstrating against the removal of the election polls from Cavetown to Smithsburg, in said county, referred, 332.

Petition from sundry citizens of, remonstrating against the exemption from taxation of the Maryland and Virginia bridge in said county, 351; referred *ib.*

Leave to bring in a bill to change the place of holding elections in the 7th district of, 430, bill reported, 432; bill passed and sent to the Senate, 598; returned passed by the Senate, 863.

A bill reported, to authorize the commissioners of, to levy a sum of money therein mentioned, for the support of public schools in said county, 432; bill passed and sent to the Senate, 598; bill returned, passed by the Senate, 723.

A bill reported, to change the place of holding the elections in the seventh election district of Washington county, 432.

A bill reported, entitled, an act to compel persons taking an appeal from the decision of any Justice of the Peace to the Circuit Court of, to pay all costs on said judgment, before an appeal can be taken, 97; bill rejected, 458.

A bill from the Senate, entitled, an act to authorize the Treasurer to pay to Isaac Nesbit, of, certain moneys improperly paid by him into the Treasury, as Clerk of Washington County Court, 548; bill passed and returned to the Senate, 694.
