2. Andrew Ragg of ---- County (Prot.), appointed by Customs Commissioners to succeed Yeates at Pocomoke, 30 May 1766; entered office 28 Aug. 1766 (AM, XIV, 311; Audit Office, b. 822, r. 1072); granted leave to remove to Great Britain, 31 March 1779 (AM, XXI, 333).

1. John Glasgow of Annapolis (Prot.), appointed Comptroller of Chester by Customs Commissioners about 30 May 1766; sworn 27 Sept. 1766 (Gilmor Papers, II, 44); granted leave to remove to Great Britain, 23 March 1779 (AM, XXI, 327).
