

12. John Llewellyn of St. Mary's County (Prot.), appointed shortly before September, 1692 (Ibid., 1. 14a, f. 4).

13. John Bouye of St. Mary's County (Prot.), sworn 30 Jan. 1692/3; dismissed 5 Aug. 1697 (Ibid., 1. 15c, f. 24; XIII, 197) but served almost a year longer.

14. Edward Batson of Calvert County (Prot.), sworn 28 May 1698 (Test. Proc., 1. 17, f. 134). Resigned to be Clerk of Charles County.

15. Col. William Bladen of Annapolis (Prot., wife Cath.), appointed 14 Aug. 1699 (Ibid., 1. 18a, f. 2); resigned in June, 1700.

16. William Taylard, appointed 2 July 1700 (Ibid., 1. 18b, f. 1); resigned in August, 1708.

17. Thomas Bordley of Annapolis (Prot.), appointed 18 Aug. 1708 (Ibid., 1. 21, f. 50); resigned in August, 1712.

18. Evan Jones of Annapolis (Prot.), com. 20 Aug. 1712 (Ibid., 1. 22, f. 131).

19. Benjamin Tasker, Sr. of Annapolis (Prot., mother probably Cath., wife's mother Cath., son-in-law of William Bladen above), appears at February Court, 1714/5 (Ibid., 1. 22, f. 424) resigned in July, 1718 to be Surveyor and Searcher of Annapolis.

20. John Beard of Annapolis (Prot., brother-in-law of Thomas Bordley above), com. 4 Aug. 1718 (Ibid., 1. 23, f. 222); soon resigned; died in 1719.

21. Philip Howard of Annapolis (Prot.), com. 14 Nov. 1718 (Ibid., 1. 23, f. 236).
