

## COURT OF CHANCERY—

to ascertain whether said Records shall be completed, with power to report, &c., 371 ; message from the Senate concurring, 386.

A bill reported, entitled an act to provide for the recording, indexing and binding of the proceedings of the late High Court of Chancery, 764 ; proceedings on bill, 764.

COURTS—Leave to bring in a bill to enlarge the powers of the various Courts in this State having equity jurisdiction, in relation to the enforcement of the vendor's lien on real estate, 199 ; bill reported, 304 ; bill amended, 639.

A bill from the Senate entitled an act to regulate the holding of the terms of the Circuit Courts within the sixth judicial circuit, 517 ; bill passed and returned to the Senate, 779.

A bill from the Senate entitled an act for the dispatch of business in the Superior Court and Court of Common Pleas in Baltimore city, 682.

A bill entitled a further supplement to provide for carrying into effect the 22d section of the 4th article of the Constitution so far as relates to Courts of equity in the city of Baltimore, 694 ; bill passed and sent to the Senate, 695.

Leave to bring in a bill to regulate the fees of the criers of the Superior Court, the Court of Common Pleas and the Criminal Court of Baltimore city, 23, bill reported, 129.

Leave to bring in a bill to increase the compensation of the Judges of the Orphans' Court of Charles county, 24.

Leave to bring in a bill to give the Circuit Courts of this State to sell remainder and reversionary interests in real estate, 24.

Leave to bring in a bill to enlarge and define the Jurisdiction of the Orphans' Courts of this State, 24.

Order adopted that the committee on the Judiciary be instructed to enquire and report to this House, whether and to what extent it would be promotive of the public interest, to give to the Circuit Courts, plenary
