

INSPECTORS AND INSPECTIONS—

Order adopted that the bill entitled an act relating to Foreign Corporations and their agencies, heretofore referred to the committee on the, be referred to the committee on Corporations, 92.

Petitions to alter the present mode of inspecting cord wood in the city of Baltimore, referred, 104, 198.

Petition of B. M. Rhodes & Co., praying the passage of a law for the inspection of all manufactured, prepared and mixed manures, referred, 104; bill reported, 714; bill amended, passed and sent to the Senate, 715.

A communication from the Baltimore city board of trade, protesting against a change in the inspection laws, referred, 125.
