

**RESOLUTION NO. 27—**

December session, 1833, 48; bill passed, 49; passed by the Senate, 139, 140.

**REVELL, JAMES**—Petition from, asking compensation for professional services rendered the State as counsel by appointment of the Governor, with certificate of appointment enclosed, referred, 133; bill reported, 410; bill passed and sent to the Senate, 479; passed by the Senate, 760.

**RICHARDS, SOLOMON**—Petition to allow, a free negro, to pass title to his real estate, referred, 11.

**ROADS**—Memorial for the removal of the first toll gate on the Baltimore and Washington Turnpike Road, referred, 70.

Leave to bring in a bill to prohibit the President, Managers and Company of the Baltimore and Frederick Turnpike Road, from collecting tolls on their road within one mile of the corporate limits of the city of Baltimore, 230.

Leave to bring in a bill to secure the greater safety of persons traveling on railroads in this State, 230.

Report of the Committee on, 231, 232.

Leave to bring in a bill granting the County Commissioners of the several counties of this State, the exclusive power to open, alter and close roads in their respective counties, 500.

A bill entitled an act to widen the public road from Georgetown to Georgetown Cross Roads, and from Massey's Cross Roads and Chesterville to Georgetown Cross Roads, and to straighten the road from Chesterville to Georgetown Cross Roads, 706; bill passed and sent to the Senate, 707.
