On motion of Mr. Ford, of Baltimore county,

Leave was granted the Baltimore county delegation to bring in a bill to increase the wages of laborers on the public roads in Baltimore county.

On motion of Mr. Thruston,

Leave was granted to the Allegany county delegation to introduce a bill to increase the bounty on wolf scalps in Allegany county;

Which was made the special order of the day for Friday, February 5th.

On motion of Mr. Bacon,

Leave was granted to the committee on Education to introduce a bill to incorporate "Havre de Grace Academy," and also granting an annual appropriation toward the endowment thereof.

Mr. Dail, from the committee on Claims, reported favorably on a bill entitled, an act appropriating a sum of money to William A. Spencer, Clerk of the Court of Appeals of Maryland for fees due him;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Burgess, from a select committee, reported favorably on a bill entitled, an act to change the name of Jacob Morris, of Charles county, to John David Hanson.
