That by the act of the General Assembly, at the same session, chapter 75, the Governor was, in the manner, expressed and authorized, in respect to the western boundary line of this State, beginning at the Fairfax stone, and running thence due north to the line of the State of Pennsylvania. That in pursuance of the request and authority contained in the foregoing act of Assembly, the late Governor of Maryland, did open a correspondence with the Governor of Virginia in relation to the retracing and marking the said boundary line.
