For support of convicts in jail in Cumberland county during the year 1853 :

319 prisoners at \$2.25 per week, - - - \$1,678.50

For their support in 1857 :

1,047 prisoners at \$2.25 per week, - - - \$5,256.33

Of which in 1853, 154 was for drunkenness,

Of which, in 1857, 732 was for drunkenness.

For support of convicts in jail, in Kennebec county during the year 1853.

108 prisoners, at \$2.25 per week, - - - \$1,003.76

For their support in 1857 :

204 prisoners at \$2.25 per week, - - - \$1,998.66

Of which, in 1853, 25 was for drunkenness.

Of which, in 1857, 84 was for drunkenness.
