Endorsed, "passed by year and nays."

Which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on Judiciary; also,

Returned the bill entitled, an act to provide for procuring for the State Library, copies of sundry papers relating to the history of the colony of Maryland; also,

The bill entitled, an act to authorise the trustees of Churchville Presbyterian congregation to hold certain real estate;

Severally endorsed, "passed by yeas and nays."
