Leave was granted to the committee on Judiciary, to introduce a bill entitled, an act to protect the proprietors of mineral lands in Allegany county;

Leave was granted to the committee on Judiciary, to introduce a bill for an act to regulate the sale of Anthracite Bituminous and Mineral Coal;

On motion of Mr. Rohrer,

Leave was granted to the Washington county delegation, to introduce a bill authorising the Mayor and Council of Hagerstown, to levy an annual tax to defray expenses of lighting the streets of said town;

Leave was granted to the committee on Colored Population, to introduce a bill authorising Charles A. McCoy, to remove a negro slave from the State of Mississippi to Cecil county, in this State;

On motion of Mr. Stirling,
