five citizens of Allegany county, praying the passage of a law for the speedy adjustment of the Boundary line of this State;

Which was referred to the special committee already appointed on that subject.

Mr. Thruston presented a petition from sundry Coal owners and operators in Allegany county, remonstrating against the proposed change of the law regulating Pilotage;

Which was received and laid on the table to be taken up when the bill is under consideration.

Mr. Root presented a petition from Wm. Beam, and other citizens of Frederick county, praying the passage of a law for the protection of useful birds;

Which was referred to the committee on Agriculture.

Mr. Stirling presented a memorial on behalf of the College of St. James, asking an amendment of their charter;

Which was referred to the committee on Corporations.

Mr. Stirling offered the following order:

Ordered, That Otho Scott and Hiram McCullough, commissioners appointed by the Legislature, to codify the laws of the State, report forthwith, in detail to this House, how much of their work is completed, and what progress they have made in perfecting their undertaking, and that the clerk of this House transmit to the said commissioners, a copy of this order;

Which was adopted.

Mr. Grieves offered the following order:

Ordered, That it be entered on the Journal that Mr. Dail, of Dorchester county, is absent in consequence of sickness in his family;

Which was adopted.

Mr. Wickes offered the following order:

Ordered, That a committee of three be appointed, to examine, in conjunction with the Librarian, whether all the acts of Assembly in their original and unabridged form, are now in the Library, and to report upon the practicability of supplying the deficiency if any such should exist;

Which was adopted.

Mr. Mackubin offered the following order:

Ordered, That the Speaker be requested to appoint an additional page and assistant folder, whose pay shall not exceed one dollar a day each, for such time as their services may be required;

Mr. Landing moved to lay the said order on the table;
