Mr. Mackubin proposed the following as an additional section:

Sec. 8. And be it enacted, That a copy of this act shall be furnished by the clerk of the Circuit Court for Anne Arundel county, to each person residing within the city of Annapolis, and within five miles thereof, who shall receive a license under the provisions of this bill, for which he shall receive fifty cents; and the clerk shall, before he delivers any license to the parties aforesaid, administer and endorse upon the said license the following oath or affirmation:

I, A. B., do swear upon the Holy Evangely of Almighty God, that I will faithfully comply with the provisions of this act; Which was assented to.
