funding of a certain sum of money paid into the State Treasury; also,

Reported on a Senate bill entitled, an act for the relief of the Sheriff of Kent county, asked that the committee be excused from its consideration.

Mr. Stirling, chairman of the committee on Ways and means, reported favorably on the bill entitled, an act making appropriations for the support of the Government, for the year ending on the first day of January, 1859;

Which was read the first time, and made the order of the day for Tuesday next.

Mr. Dail, from the committee on Claims, reported favorably on a bill entitled, an act to compensate Josiah H. Gordon for legal services;

Mr. Dail, from the committee on Claims, reported favorably on a bill entitled, an act to refund to Horace Resley, of Allegany county, money erroneously paid by him into the treasury:

Mr. McKinstry, from the committee on Agriculture, reported favorably on a bill entitled, an act to regulate the sale and purchase of potatoes and apples in this State;
