

Mr. Contee, from the committee on Currency, reported favorably, with amendment, the Senate bill entitled, an act to amend an act entitled, an act to continue the corporate existence of the several banking institutions therein mentioned, passed January session, 1853, chapter 241.

Mr. Crowley, from the committee on Roads and Highways, reported favorably on the Senate bill entitled, an act authorising the County Commissioners of Baltimore county to open an avenue adjacent to the eastern boundary of the city of Baltimore, from the intersection of O'Donnell and Third streets of the Canton Company lands, northwardly with Third street to Bank street, thence with Bank street, westwardly to First street, and thence northwardly to Monument street extended.

Mr. Dail, from the committee on Claims, reported favorably on a bill entitled, an act to refund to Thomas E. Martin, William Weedon and William V. Stinchcomb, a certain sum of money illegally forfeited and paid by them into the treasury ; also,
