Mr. Lynch, of Baltimore county, from a select committee, reported favorably, the bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the School Commissioners of Baltimore county ;

Mr. Mackubin, from a select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, an act to authorise the Commissioners of Anne Arundel county to levy a sum of money for the enlarge-ment and repair of the Alms-house of said county ;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Todd, from a select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, an act for the benefit of Primary School District No. 3, and Election District No. 2, in Caroline county ;

Mr. Riddlemoser, from a select committee, reported a bill entitled, an act to carry into effect the 39th section of the 3d article of the Constitution, by exempting from execution a certain amount of property ;
