

In section 1. They recommend the following amendment, after the word "vessels" in 2nd line insert "of two hundred tons burthen and over." In 6th line of same section strike out the word south, and insert "south south-west," and the rejection of the amendment proposed by Mr. Grievess, appended to the end of this section.

The section 2. They recommend the insertion of the following amendment after the word "vessels" in the 1st line "of two hundred tons burthen and over," and the striking out in the 3rd and 4th lines of the words "and not embraced in the first section of this act."

They also recommend the striking out of the 4th and 6th sections of said bill.
