State a sett of weights and measures, and each State furnish to its several jurisdictions a duplicate thereof,

Resolved, That the Maryland standard, is most respectfully recommended as the one to be adopted,

Resolved, That an authenticated copy of these resolutions be forwarded to each of our Senators and Representatives in Congress, and to the Governor of each State of the United States;
