The bill entitled, an act to change the corporate name, style and title of the Mechanics' Exchange and Saving's Company, incorporatd by the General Assembly of Maryland, at January session, 1852, chapter 306, to that of Exchange Bank.

A bill entitled, an act amendatory of an act entitled, an act to incorporate the proprietors of the Rose Bank Cemetery, passed at February session 1847, chapter 293;

A bill entitled, an act to compensate Bradley T. Johnson, for the trial of certain cases in the Court of Appeals as counsel on the part of the State by appointment of the Governor;
