Strike out the word "magistrate," in 2nd line, section 1, and insert in lieu thereof "justice of the peace;"

Strike out the word "magistrate or magistrates," in the 6 and 7th lines, section 1, and insert in lieu thereof "justice or justices;"

Strike out the word "magistrate," in the title and insert, instead the words "justices of the peace;"
