# NEGATIVE.

Mr. Kilgour—1.

The said bill was then sent to the Senate.

Mr. Kilgour moved that the House adjourn;

Determined in the negative.

The Secretary of the Senate returned the following bills:

A bill entitled, an act to provide for the representation of the State by counsel, in certain cases now pending in the Court of Appeals, on appeal from the criminal court of Baltimore city, arising under the license laws of this State, and appropriating a sum of money to pay the person whom the Governor may employ as counsel, for his services in such cases;

Endorsed "rejected."

A bill entitled, an act to lay out and establish a new election district in Dorchester county, to be called election district number twelve, or Wililamsburg district;

A bill entitled, an act to refund to Amos Osborn, collector of the second election district in Harford county, George D. A bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Old Town Savings Institution;

Endorsed, "passed by yeas and nays,"

A bill entitled, an act to make valid a deed from John Lewis attorney of Mary Turner, to Adam Holt;

Endorsed, "passed by yeas and nays;"

A bill entitled, an act to authorise the Comptroller of the State, to pay the balance of pension therein mentioned;
