The bill entitled, an act making appropriations for the support of the government for the year ending on the first day of January, eighteen hundred and fifty-nine.

Endorsed, "passed by yeas and nays, with proposed amendments."

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED:

Sec. 1, line 68, after the word "dollars," insert the following, "for the Maryland Penitentiary thirty thousand dollars, said sum to be payable after the 1st day of May next."

In same sec., line 68 and 69, after the words "African colonization," strike out "ten thousand dollars," and insert instead "five thousand dollars."

In same sec. in line 206, strike out "seven thousand," and insert "four thousand."

In line 207, strike out the words "five thousand," and insert "four thousand."

Add to the section these words, "provided, that said sums of money shall be received by said commissioners, in full liquidation of all claims for their services performed or to be performed by virtue of their appointment under article 3, section 7 of the Constitution.

Add the following, "for the payment of printing the reports of Otho Scott and Hiram McCullough, commissioners
