"An act to grant an additional donation to St. John's College."

The bill entitled, an act to regulate the Weighing and Measuring of Wheat in Baltimore city,

In section 1, line 2, after the word "all," strike out the word "wheat," and insert "grain and seed;"

Which was not assented to.

Determined in the affirmative.
