A bill entitled, an act to incorporate certain persons as trustees of the United Brethren in Christ Church in Carroll county, to be called the Mount Pleasant Church;

A bill entitled, an act authorising the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, to issue the bonds or inscribed stock, to complete a new jail;

A bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Port Deposit Library Association;

Severally endorsed, "passed by yeas and nays."

A bill entitled, an act making appropriations for the support of the government for the year ending on the first day of January, eighteen hundred and sixty.

A Bill entitled, an act for the benefit of James Wheeler, a free person of color, of Caroline county.

A bill entitled, an act for the benefit of Primary Schools in District number Three, Election District number Two, in Caroline county.

A bill entitled, an act to allow William Stafford, of Caroline county, to bring into this State a slave for a term of years named therein.

A bill entitled, an act relating to the collection of taxes in Harford county.

Severally endorsed, "passed by yeas and nays."

A bill entitled, an act to provide for the speedy collection of state and county taxes in Baltimore county.

A bill entitled, an act to provide for the compensation of James M. Schley, for certain services performed by him under appointment of the Governor, in the Court of Appeals of Maryland.

A supplement to an act entitled, an act to incorporate a company to build a turnpike road from Woodsboro' to Monococy bridge, on the road leading to Frederick city.

A bill entitled, an act to pay John D. Toy and Schley & Haller for printing the reports of the commissioners to revise, simplify and abridge the rules of practice and pleadings.

A bill entitled, an act to grant the leave of the Legislature to a bequest made in the last will and testament of Elizabeth
