Great County of Kent The Jurors for the right honourable the Lord Prop^r that now is for the body of Great County of Kent do hereby certify that George Moor late of Chester Town in Saint Pauls Parish in Great County of Kent Carpenter the tenth day of Noon^r in the year of Our said Lord God Our thousand seven hundred and thirty eight at Chester Town and in the Parish & County of D^e Brethⁿ the Jurors of this Court with force & Arms in to the mansion house of a certain John Earls in Chester Town and within the parish & City of Salisbury and being did break & entered & removed the Children & servants of the same John Earls in the same mansion house then & there in the face of God & the same Lord Prop^r being into great terror & danger of their lives did put & other harms to the same John & to the Children & servants of the same John in the mansion house and then & there being then & there did to the great damage of the same John to the evil Example of others in such case offending and against the peace of the same Lord Prop^r his good rules & Government & Diligently L^d Do Prop^r
