 Attorney aforesaid prayeth that the said Charles to stand on aijt may  
 answer

And the aforesaid Charles in his proper Person  
 comes and defendes the said Injury whereto And saith that he  
 cannot gainsay the Indictment aforesaid against him brought in  
 any way but that he is guilty of the Transforfeit aforesaid upon him  
 Imposed as by the Indictment aforesaid alledged and whereas Submits  
 to the Court &c. Therefor it is Considered by the Justices here  
 to wit at Kent County Court at the Court house in the Town of Chester  
 in said County on the third Monday of November being the fourteenth day  
 of said month in the year of Our Lord God One thousand hundred and thirty and  
 eight. That the aforesaid Charles pay the sum of One hundred and ten Pds  
 Current money of Maryland as a fine for Committing the Offendre  
 Also it is Considered by the Justices abovesigned that he aforesaid last  
 mentioned that the aforesaid Charles pay the sum of three hundred and  
 eighty One pounds of tobacco Cots according to the Ordinance  
 to the several Officers of this Court &c.

Ordered by this Court here that the sum aforesaid be delivered the Sheriff of  
 Kent County. The aforesaid Charles not having whereale to satisfy the sum aforesaid  
 nor no One offering to pay it for him. Thereupon he is committed  
 into the custody of the Sheriff of Kent County until the sum aforesaid be  
 satisfied. It is also Ordered by this Court here that the aforesaid Charles  
 give Security for the fees and expences on the premises aforesaid to  
 the several Officers of this Court &c. And having no One to Offer  
 nor no One offering for him. Thereupon he is committed into  
 the custody of the Sheriff of Kent County until he give Security aforesaid
