the said Henry Smith appearing to the Oath of the Jurors and
And upon their Oath do say that Henry Smith is guilty as
he stands indicted and by Math^r Hyuson their foreman all
do say & Therefore it is considered by the Justices here to
wit at Great County Court at the Court house in the Town of Chester
in said County on the third day of Novem^r being the fourth
day of said month in the year of Our Lord seventeen hundred thirty
and eight that the said Henry Smith shall stand in and upon
the Gallary in the County and for the space of One hour And
shall be whiped at the publick whiping post in the same
County with fifteen Lashes upon the bare Back of him the said
Henry and the blood to appear And it is Com^{and}ed to the
Sherrif of Great County that he do the Execution thereof upon him
the said Henry immediately after the said And it is further
considered that the said Henry do pay unto W^m Larniche
the sum of two hundred fifty pounds of tob^o being the four fold of
the value of the goods and so as of stolen and that the said Henry
do return to the said William the said goods or the single value
thereof being Sixty two pounds of tob^o. And he not having
where with to pay the four fold as mentioned Thereupon
he is committed into the Custody of the Sherrif of Great County until the
four fold be satisfied It is also considered by the Justices at
the time and place as that the said Henry pay the sum of seven
hundred twenty seven pounds of tob^o Cash as money on the
premises and to the Officers of this Court & Ordered by the
Court here that the said Henry give Security for the Four and seven
ing on the premises and to the Officers of this Court And he
having no One to Offer nor no One offering for him thereupon
