His Lordship's Command was given to the Sheriff of Front  
 County on the twentieth day of March in the  
 twenty fifth year of Our Dom<sup>n</sup> in the year  
 of Our Lord seventeen hundred thirty eight that he send in his  
 proper person before the Justice of this County Court now holden  
 at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third  
 Tuesday of March bringing along with you Mathias Woolley of St Pauls  
 Parish in the County of Labaror by you taken & in your custody  
 altho' such detained as by the return of Our writt in Che said Court be  
 for Our said Justice appears to answer unto a certain Judgment  
 for assaulting John Hodgov. And that the said Sheriff have at the  
 time and place of the said writt And receive here to wit at Front  
 County Court at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said County  
 on the third Tuesday of March being the twentieth day of said month  
 in the year of Our Lord seventeen hundred thirty eight Com<sup>rs</sup>  
 Simon Wilmer Esq. Sheriff of Front County Or make return thereof  
 to the Court here thereon Jurors in the following words to wit

 Front County The Jurors for the right honourable the Lord Prop<sup>r</sup>  
 that now is for the body of Front County and upon their Oath do shew  
 that Mathias Woolley late of St Pauls Parish in the County of  
 Labaror the first day of May Anno Dom<sup>n</sup> seventeen hundred and  
 thirty eight at his Parish and in the County and within the Jurisd<sup>ic</sup>  
 of this Court in person John Hodgov against the peace of the said  
 Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> and there being with force & arms an assault  
 did make and the same John then there did beat wound & villy  
 treat so that of his life it was greatly dispaired and other harms  
 to him then there did to the great damage of the same John
