This Lordship's Commission was given to the Sheriff of Kent County on the 10th day of Edm. Dulany the first day of June in the 24th year of our Dom. 4th in the year of our Lord 1738 that he should immediately take the body of Edm. Dulany and him safe keep so that he had his body before the Justice of our present Court to answer unto a Complaint of M^r Jacob Francis.
