

And the ap Elisha in his proper person comes and defends the
 former injury which he saith that he care not gain say the said
 Judgment but as ap against him brought nor can he say but that
 he is guilty of the promises ap above upon him imposed as by
 the Judgment as it is alleged & thereof Submits to the Court
 Therefore it is considered by the Justice here to wit that the Court
 at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the
 third Tuesday of March being the twentieth day of said month in
 the year of Our Lord seven hundred thirty eight that the ap
 Elisha had pay the sum of One hundred ten shillings money
 of Maryland as a fine for committing the violation of an Act
 of Assembly in that case made & provided & Also it is
 considered by the Justice at the time & place aforesaid that the said
 Elisha pay the sum of three hundred and six shillings
 of tobacco costs accruing on the promises aforesaid to the Officers of
 this Court & —

Ordered by this Court here that the fine
 ap be delivered the sherrif of Kent County And Simon Welmer and
 sherrif of the said County present herein Court Acknowledge the
 receipt of the same —

Ordered by this Court here that the
 ap Elisha had give security for the Good Accruing on the Office
 ap to the Officers of this Court — Thereupon Elisha had
 Henry Trulack & Boy Green of Kent County Labourers and sherrif
 here in Court in their proper persons Acknowledge themselves
 to be Indebted to his Lordship the right honourable the Lord Proprietor
 of Maryl. in the sum of five hundred pounds of tobacco each to be
 made and Charged on their bodies goods & Chattels Land & Tenements
 for the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors with Condition
 to this req. that the ap Elisha had do pay the Good Accruing
 on the promises as ap to the severall Officers of this Court Then
 this req. shd be void & the remain in full force & Virtue

Ordered by this Court here that the ap Elisha give security to
 the County to keep harmless from the maintenance of the Child
 Thereupon Elisha had Henry Trulack & Boy Green
 of Kent County Labourers and present herein Court in their
 proper persons Acknowledge themselves Indebted to his
 Lordship the right honourable the Lord Proprietor of Maryland in
 the sum of five thousand pounds of tobacco each to be made and
 Charged on their bodies goods & Chattels Land & Tenements
 for the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors with
 Condition to this req. that Elisha had do keep harmless
 the County ap from the maintenance of the Bastard Child
