That he should take Nathaniel Hyuson Son of the Narrows of Eastern Neck Island if he should be found in Barbours and him vato keep so that he have his body before the Justice of Our said County Court to be held at Our Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday of March next to answer unto a Proccution for not keeping a sufficient Boat or Show and for not keeping sufficient Attendance for transporting Persons over the same ferry according to his Duty as ferryman and Agreement with the said Court And that the said flier had at the time & place of the said Writ to Our now held to wit at Kent County Court at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday of March being the twentieth day of said month in the year of Our Lord One thousand seven hundred thirty & eight Cometh Simon Wilmer Gent flier of Kent County and made return thereof to the Court here therein Indorsed as follows

That on this twentieth day of March Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred thirty eight Cometh hereunto Court of the Right honorable the Lord Propy held for Kent County at Chester Town Joshua George Gent who in this part for the said Lord Propy Proprietor to be for James Harris Esq. & his Exors: also Justice of the same Lord Propy for the said County said give the Court here to understand & be informed that on the fifteenth day of Nov. Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred & thirty seven at a Court held for said County at Chester Town and a certain Nathl. Hyuson Son of the said County had agreed with the said Court to keep a sufficient Boat or Show Allowed for transporting Persons over at the Narrows of Eastern Neck Island for the year ensuing for which Service the said Nathl. was to have an Allowance in the County of Eighteen pounds Curr. money of Maryland That Nowe the said Nathaniel Hyuson his Duty disregarded did not keep a sufficient Boat or Show at the Narrows of Eastern Neck Island as at the County as aforesaid he did not sufficiently attend the same nor caused it to be Allowed to the great Prejudice and detriment of the Inhabitants of the County as well to the sole Example of all others in the like case offending wherefore the said Joshua George on behalf of the said Lord Propy Prays the Advice of the Court here in the Premises and that
