County and Especially toward Dennis Sullavan & that they or either
of them shall not do or procure to be done any bodily hurt to v. Dennis
that their Recogⁿ to be void otherwise to remain in full force
Power & Virtue in Law taken and Acknowledged before me as
Witness my hand & Seal the day & year aforesaid. William Jon^r
Kent County J^r The Jurors for the right honourable the Lord Prop^{ty}
that now is for the body of Kent County upon their Oath do protest that
John Nemo late of Kent County Planter Edw. Crow late of said County
Planter and Thomas Unitt late of said County Planter on the first
day of March Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and thirty eight with force
and Arms at the County of Kent and upon a certain Dennis Sullavan
in the presence of God and the said Lord Prop^{ty} then and there being an
Assault did make and him the said Dennis then & there did beat wound
and evilly treat and other harms to him the said Dennis then there
did to the great Damage of him the said Dennis and against the
peace of the said Lord Prop^{ty} his good rule and Government. George

that their and their Surety's Recogⁿ taken as aforesaid for their peace of their

discharged as prayed. John Nemo, Edw. Crow, Thom^s
Unitt their Oath of their Recogⁿ taken as aforesaid is by this Court
here discharged there being no cause shown to the contrary
