of this County that then this Recog. to be void & of no Effect other-
wise to remain in full force power & Virtue in Law —

in the Town of Charters in said County on the third Monday of
March being the twentieth day of said month in the year of Our
Said most Excellent hundred thirty and eight Cometh George Moor in

may be discharged. Ordered by this Court here that George
Moor his Recog. taken as aforesaid be discharged as prayed

here discharged there being no cause shown to the contrary
