 sum of ten pounds current money of the Province aforesaid -
 Nathaniel Hywon & W^m McLean in the sum of five pounds
 the money each to be made and lodged on their body goods
 Chatter Lands and Tenements for the use of his said Lordship his
 heirs and Successors With Condition that the said John Corner do
 make his personale Appearance before the Justice of our next
 County Court to be held at our Courthouse in the Town of Chester in
 said County on the third Tuesday of June next then and there to
 answer unto such things as will be objected against him on
 behalf of his Lordship And in the mean time to keep the
 Peace and be of good behaviour, especially to William Trulock
 Then this Recognizance to be void And to remain in full
 force in Law
